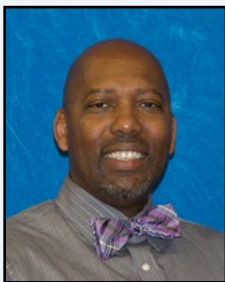


John S. White

The Access Management Branch (AMB) is comprised of 16 security administrators who are responsible for provisioning and de-provisioning access to National Finance Center's (NFC) Payroll Personnel applications, in addition to *EmpowHR*, webTA, Direct Premium Remittance System (DPRS), Federal Employee Health Benefits Centralized Enrollment Clearinghouse Systems (CLER), Reporting Center, Web applications, hosted systems, Active Directory, and Windows.

The group also has three analysts whose responsibilities include developing, generating, and analyzing reports required to monitor and track performance; monitoring and enforcing internal controls; and developing software solutions to increase efficiency and effectiveness of operations.

The branch manages over 45,000 accounts and is one of the few organizations at NFC that regularly interacts with all NFC organizations and all customers serviced by NFC. In order to service these accounts, AMB processes approximately 800 requests per month and utilizes various programming languages, database management systems, report generators, productivity tools and operating systems to complete daily tasks.

AMB also provides a variety of training courses on a monthly basis to Agency Security Officers, and quarterly training to NFC's Security Coordinators. Schedules and training materials, as well as other resources, can be found on NFC's Web site, www.nfc.usda.gov, under the Security Corner link.
