Minutes

1. BI Team –

- a. HANA ULO Status – testing is continuing to go very well. BI Team recapped on several detailed resolutions to errors and questions sent by Agencies testers.
 - i. PA/Travel auth # was not appearing – fixed
 - ii. Variable screen – search for list of variables – derivation process improved; search runs more efficiently
 - iii. Cost Centers not consistently populated because of a validity date mismatch – corrected
 - iv. FY/period combination – not native field on FTR or ULO report – field was added
 - v. Functional Area not available on variable entry screen – field was added
 - vi. Differences in balances at summary level to FTR – differences were result of 2 types of documents not being populated – this was corrected
 - vii. WCF requested that the report be modified to allow multiple business areas.
 - 1. It was explained that this is a required forced limitation to ensure data volumes searched do not exceed system capacity. This report is a real time report running against existing data concurrently with transaction processing within the system. Searching multiple business areas in one report slows FMMI processing and has resulted in FMMI system crashes.
 - 2. It was suggested that agencies requiring multiple business areas utilize the BOBJ scheduler function to have reports made available according to predetermined need and that macros be used to combine reports for business areas as applicable. BI Backend Processing Branch representatives are available to assist with BOBJ scheduler request.
 - 3. In addition, a summary report is being considered that would mitigate difficulties caused by the inability to produce reports for multiple business areas or at the Treasury Symbol level.at predetermined needed because
 - viii. Testers are encouraged to retest and report any errors found to Leslie Burkhardt (leslie.burkhardt@cfo.usda.gov) . Issues must be reported timely to be addressed effectively.
- b. FS – asked if there will be an extension for testing, possibly to February 27th? Yes.

2. Security –

- a. Security team will address FSA requests re: FPAC blended roles offline.

3. Open Discussion –
