Scope:	Currently, when FEMA attempts to use Transaction Code (TC) 67, OWCP Injury Leave on the T & A for an Intermittent Special employee, the T & A rejects in the edit process. Due to this situation, FEMA is forced to manually process the T & A through the SPPS Web based application. FEMA is requesting to allow Intermittent Special employee's to code their T & A with TC 67 OWCP Injury Leave for personal injury or disease sustained while in the performance of duty.
Assumptions:	When the Intermittent Special category is selected in WebTA, WebTA sends a code 6 in the TYPE-EMP-INTERMITTENT field.
