Background: The DOJ_PAR_IN_WORKFLOW query will ONLY include New Hires with an Effective Date of the current date or earlier; the query will not include "future dated" New Hire actions in INI Status or in Workflow. DEA would like for the query to include ALL New Hires in INI or in Workflow regardless of the Effective Date.
Currently, PeopleSoft view "EMPLMT_SRCH_QRY" is designed to retrieve only one row per EMPLID and EMPL_RCD combination (even if criteria in the SQL are set to greater than or equal to effective date). It does not retrieve "New Hire" future dated rows.
FRD change:  Make the following changes to the records in the DOJ query: "DOJ_PAR_IN_WRKFLOW" by modifying the delivered security view to retrieve all future dated actions as well as "New Hire" future dated rows.
